Brief Description of Duckworth Worcestershire Trust and WRE

Along side the scrap store there is a well stocked art and craft shop, an art reference library, an artist database, an art workshop space which can be hired, a community repaint scheme and a wood recycling store. Membership is necessary for the scrap store but members of the public are welcome to come and look around. Non members can buy from the craft shop, repaint and wood store.

Job Description

To use a cookie cutter system of dies to create custom designs for sale in the WRE craft shop and for use by the WREmakers, from an array of scrap materials .

Will include periods of lone working in the die cutting room with supervision from WRE project workers on hand at all times.

Attention is needed at all times for continued safe working of the machine.

A certain level of dexterity is required and prolonged standing is necessary for the safe use of the machine

Training and requirements

Following the application process and two references a simple induction of the building and the necessary house keeping welfare; full training will be given on safe use of the dies and die cutter and manual handling techniques.

A CRB enhanced disclosure check may be required.
